<p>Brief Introduction</p>	
<p>Oral squamous cell carcinoma (OSCC) is the most common malignant tumor in the head and neck and continues to be associated with substantial morbidity and mortality worldwide. The overall survival of patients with OSCC has not markedly improved over recent decades. OSCC treatments have been based on single or multimodal therapies with surgery, radiotherapy, chemotherapy, and immunotherapy depending on tumor stage. However, treatment recommendations may differ among countries due to technology, human resources, medical facilities, insurance systems, and economic situation of the country. This presentation reviews several national /professional guidelines to make a comparison, showing a clinical Japanese guideline in oral cancer.</p>
